Gaps in public services result in high prices for water for residents. Only 13% of residents have public water service in Viana.






Latrines

When there is a lack of sewer connections, open spaces, gullies, and streams are utilized for sanitation.




Solid Waste

More households report weekly rubbish collection in Viana than in Luanda as a whole.




Housing

Because there is open and agricultural land in Viana, the average density (eight people per acre) does not reflect the actual densities in the most crowded areas - where the density may be more than 300 per hectare.




Education
